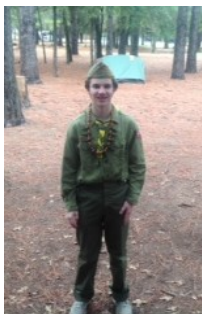

What's a Bin Account? How much is in it?

What's a bin account, you ask? Decades ago, T1000 collected newspapers for recycling. Each Scout had a metal bin, and the money from the newspapers in each bin was credited to each Scout according to how much he collected. We don't have metal bins anymore, but the term "bin account" is still used for funds accumulated individually by each scout and credited toward his camping and other fees.

In early November each family will be sent an email with the total amount in your Scout's Bin Account – that is, IF you have an email ID in the troop records listed for the "primary" parent. If not sure, see Carolyn Linscott, advancement Chairperson at any Monday night meeting.
