Role Descriptions:

Cook: Prepare meal, prepare water for dish washing, supervise meal cleanup

H2O/Trash/Fire: Get water when needed, gather firewood when necessary, start fire when requested. Prepare charcoal for cooking, This requires getting out of bed before the cook or with the cook at breakfast. Haul trash to trailer or dumpster when needed or requested.

KP: Wash dishes, wash utensils used for meal preparation. Each patrol member is responsible for washing their own mess kit.

Campsite Cleanup: Clean Campsite by picking up trash, Cleanup eating area, Form a police line by the patrol members to pick up trash. Assure site is clean before patrol leaves.

Each patrol member is responsible for their "Job" from the start of the meal or cracker barrel to the start of the next meal.

Everyone is responsible for the loading and unloading of the trailer at Ed Center
