

Introducing the "A Scout is Reverent" Summer Camp activity patch

By doing your duty to God and demonstrating that a "A Scout is Reverent," youth and adult can earn a brand new patch at Summer Camp. Even if you aren't going to a Circle 10 Council camp, you can still earn the patch.

The requirements are easy:

1. Attend a worship service if offered at their camp.

In the event the camp does not offer a worship service, the unit may conduct a Scout's Own service or vesper service on its own or in conjunction with other units.

2. Lead grace a before a meal or other event.

This can be done on at a camp-wide meal or in the unit's campsite.

To permit youth to fulfill this requirement, adults seeking the award should refrain from leading grace at camp-wide meals but ought to lead grace in the unit's campsite.

- **3. Participate in at least three devotional activities,** either by preparing and delivering a devotional or attending the devotional. It is preferred that this occur within the unit at its campsite. Adults may complete this requirement by assisting youth in preparing devotionals.
- 4. Become informed about the Religious Award for your faith: (Do one of the following)
- a. Youth must learn about the Religious Emblem of their faith and age group.
- b. If a Scout has already earned his faith's Religious Emblem, he must help explain the award program to another Scout.

Note: Adult leaders must commit to help make a presentation on the Duty to God Religious Emblems program at a troop meeting or to serve as a counselor in their local faith community or troop for the Religious Emblems Program.
