MyScouting Training

To begin, make an account at my.scouting.org. Boy Scouts of America offers training courses online at my.scouting.org. It also includes a Dashboard that shows what training you've completed. Required Training



Youth Protection training (YPT) is required for all BSA registered volunteers and is a joining requirement.

Youth Protection training must be taken every two years. If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current at the time of recharter, the volunteer will not be re-registered.



Position-Specific (Role-Based) Courses

These instructor-led courses are designed to help Scouters learn how to effectively carry out their Scouting roles. In most cases, completing the course will make a Scouter "trained" for the role(s) covered in the course. E-learning syllabus of courses may be found on the next page. Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills (IOLS)

Working as patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Specifics this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops in order to be considered "trained". The next available IOLS starts April 13th.
