Sign-up is now in progress for three key programs

- 1. *WILD* Caving Campout January 24th 26th.
- Spring Break Trip to the
 USS Lexington March 8th 12th
- Summer Camp at Camp Buck Toms, in Tennessee, July 5th - 13th (two travel days included)

Wild Caving - Reservations and Deposit Required NOW Jan 24 - 26.

We start out the year with a Wild adventure for Scouts of all ages and experience levels - perfect for a Scouts first campout with the Troop. Any Scout who has submitted an application, regardless of crossover status, may attend this Campout with the Troop (with or without parent).

Our Caving Campout will take place at Longhorn Caverns, where Scouts will have an opportunity to experience a modified "behind the scenes " Wild caving tour - often on hands and knees, in the dark (only when flashlights are turned off) and sometimes in the mud! They will travel along paths safe and well traveled - but currently off limits to the typical tour takers. This 2-1/2 hour tour is a unique program, and will only be offered to a limited number of Scouts on Saturday morning. Reservations start Monday, January 6th, and are first come, first served. I've taken the Wild tour multiple

times and it is Great Fun!

Tour will have the opportunity to take the *regular* walking tour of this amazing cavern on the same day, same time.

Following the morning at Longhorn Caverns, the Troop will visit Enchanted Rock State park for a view of some of our Planets oldest exposed rock formations, a few above ground "caves" and some very picturesque hiking. The Troop will be camping at Inks Lake Park, near Longhorn Caverns.

Live Aboard: USS Lexington Aircraft Carrier - In Port in Corpus Christi Texas Spring Break Trip - March 8

For our first Extended Campout of 2014, Troop 1000 will "take off" for the USS Lexington, where we have bunks on board reserved for two nights,

March 9-10. For new and fairly new Scouts, This is often a "warm-up" trip for summer camp. Not quite a week away from home, and comfortable bunks for at least a few days of the trip!

Scouts will experience the fun aspects of living on an Aircraft Carrier including a ships tour, dining in the ships officers mess for meals (where they can order anything they want as long as that's the one thing being served that day), and learn about the haunted parts of this famous floating fortress.

Additional activities will include a visit to a local Science and History museum where replicas of Columbus' Ships are

moored and can be toured. - a fascinating look back to 1492! Plans are underway to spend one night camping in a state park or Scout camp on the way down (by car) and an additional night on a military base on the way back.

A reservation and deposit is due on or before January 9th. Please use the attached reservation sheet to make your res-

<u>Summer Camp: Camp Buck</u> <u>Toms</u> July 5-13

This will be Troop 1000's first visit to Tennessee's Smoky Mountains area Camp Buck Tom's (although our Scout master, Mr. Diamond, went to camp there as a Scout!). Camping will be in a unique bunk-bed style "open" cabin (called an Adirondack) - so no cots needed this year!

The camp offers "all the comforts" of a typical Scout Camp, plus some exciting surprises for all! For Second year and more experienced Scouts, merit badge class signup begins in late January, and all signups should be set up for non-first year Scouts by mid February. There are High Adventure Options for experienced Scouts.

Total cost (without merit badge fees and high adventure options) will be about \$300 per scout (transportation cost - via 12-passenger vans - is still a variable, although most is expected to be covered by the Troop's Garage Sale revenue).

Deposit of \$100 is due on Feb 10th.
